How does the Lottery work?

This information should be read in conjunction with the Lottery leaflet and the Terms and Conditions.

On joining the lottery each player will be allocated a unique random number.

Providing the player has paid the full weekly subscription of £1.00 they will be entered in the draw conducted each Friday.

The computer system will randomly select the winning numbers. As at 1 May 2010 the prizes are as follows:

1 @ £1000.00
1 @ £200.00
1 @ £100.00
20 @£10.00

Rollover Prize

1. In addition there is a weekly rollover prize of £250.00. In the event of this prize not being won it is carried forward to the next week when the total rollover prize will be increased by a further £250.00.
2. Prior to the main draw the computer system will conduct a random selection to ascertain if the rollover prize is to be won. There is a 1/20 chance that the rollover draw will take place.
3. If the total rollover prize reaches £6000.00 (24 weeks) then the rollover draw will be made that week notwithstanding point 2.
4. The highest prize available will be paid to the first lottery number selected in the draw. That will be the rollover total or £1,000.00 whichever is the higher. It is therefore possible that two prizes of £1000.00 may be paid during one week.
